



## **General Roach Clean Out Prep Sheet**

### **Preparation:**

- Empty out **\*\*\*ALL CABINETS\*\*\*** drawers and any other area that roaches are seen.  
**\*\*\*Failure to do so may result in rescheduling treatment.\*\*\***
- Remove all food from the pantry and areas that roaches are seen.
- Pick up any food debris that may hinder roaches from eating the baits we use.
- Vacuum all areas as you remove the items. This will eliminate roach feces and old carcasses.
- Wipe down counters and inside cabinets (after treatment you don't want to wash any treated area).
- Unload the dishwasher.
- Cover all food/handling products with some type of plastic (torn trash bags over everything removed from the kitchen).
- Cover any fish aquariums and remove all other pets.
  - Place fish food in plastic container.
- Cover any kids items (pile on the bed with a cover).
- Cover anything that you don't want to get any pesticide on (fog is oil based and may leave any oily residue).
- Plan on being out of the house for 6-8 hours (Failure to follow these instructions may result in sickness for people or pets).**

### **After Treatment:**

- Vacuum and wipe up any carcasses found.
- Cleanout around and under fridge and oven areas.
- Place items back in cabinets and pantry. No need to empty again unless requested.
- Continue to check new items coming into your home (second hand stores especially).
- Continue to do any follow ups your technician requests (it may take multiple visits to rid your problem).
